Dr Philip Mitchell

- Dr Philip Mitchell qualified as a dentist from University College Hospital in 1989 and completed a Master of Science in Endodontics at Guy's Hospital in 1996. He was awarded the Membership in Restorative Dentistry of the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh and was subsequently accepted on to the Specialist's List in 1999.
- Senior Specialist Clinical Lecturer and Deputy Chairman of the Endodontic Examination Board at King's College London Dental Institute.
- Oversees postgraduate training and research at King's College London Dental Institute.
- Maintains a specialist private practice in London restricted to endodontics since 1997.
- Council member of the British Endodontic Society and Past President of the Langham Endodontic Study Group.
- Contributed to several textbooks, including Harty's Endodontics in Clinical Practice and Pitt Ford's Problem-Based Learning in Endodontology.
- Keynote speaker for the British Endodontic Society, European Society of Endodontology, British Association of Oral Surgeons and European Federation of Oral Surgery Societies.
- He has lectured and provided hands-on workshops widely in UK and Europe.



Dr Robert PY Ng

- Dr Ng qualified from King's College London, University of London in 1984 and worked in London as a general practitioner till 1997. He was awarded the Master of Science in Endodontics and Master of Clinical Dentistry in Endodontology (both with distinctions) by the Eastman Dental Institute (1998 and 2000 respectively).
- Dr Ng became a Fellow of the Royal Australasian College of Dental Surgeons in 2001. In 2002, he obtained the Advanced Diploma in Endodontics from the University of Hong Kong. A year later, he acquired the Membership in Restorative Dentistry of the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh and was awarded the Gold Medal in the Restorative Intercollegiate Examination. In 2005, he was admitted as fellows in the College of Dental Surgeons of Hong Kong (Endodontics) and the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine. Dr Ng was awarded the Membership in Endodontics of the Royal Australasian College of Dental Surgeons in 2008.
- Past President of the Hong Kong Endodontic Society and current chairman of Specialty Board in Endodontics of the College of Dental Surgeons of Hong Kong.
- Local examiner in the Conjoint MRD Examination and Specialty Exit Examination in Endodontics.
- Full-time member of staff in the Discipline of Conservative Dentistry and Area of Family Dentistry and Endodontics at the Faculty of Dentistry (2000 to 2005). Currently maintains a specialist endodontic private practice and teaches postgraduates part-time at the faculty.

9.00 - 10.15am	<p>Surgical Endodontics: Keys to Achieving Predictable Results</p> <p>The lecture will aim to give an evidence-based overview of surgical outcome and an anecdotal view of which factors are important with respect to this. The lecture will aim to cover all of the recent advances in surgical endodontics. (Dr Philip Mitchell)</p>

10.45 - 12.00pm	<p>Problem Solving in Management of Painful Endodontic Emergencies</p> <p>A patient turning up as an endodontic emergency at your practice could cause significant disruption to your schedule. These emergencies could present in various forms, some could be easily managed or prevented in the first place but some could only be resolved by carrying out of some form of intervention. The presentation will explore the different types of endodontic emergencies, their aetiologies, diagnoses and treatment strategies. (Dr Robert Ng)</p>

12.30 - 2.30pm	<p>Lunch/Trade Exhibition</p> <p>Table Clinic 1: 12.30 - 1.30pm Guidelines and Clinical Tips for Management of Open Apex and Immature Teeth</p> <p>The table clinic will aim to give an evidence-based overview of the treatment modalities for immature teeth: vital and non-vital. There will be an assessment of the practical challenges faced with some tips for solving these. (Dr Philip Mitchell)</p> <p>Table Clinic 2: 1.30 - 2.30pm Practical Tips on Non-surgical Endodontic Retreatment</p> <p>Faced with a tooth with failed root canal treatment, the clinician has to diagnose the cause of the failure, come up with a strategy on how to carry out endodontic retreatment and inform the patient of the prognosis of the tooth concerned. The table clinic will run through some of the commonly encountered scenarios of failed root canal treatment and its management. (Dr Robert Ng)</p>
2.30 - 3.30pm	<p>Clinical Solutions for Diagnosis and Management of Cracked Teeth</p> <p>The lecture will aim to cover the problems associated with diagnosis and treatment planning for cracked teeth. The long term prognoses of these teeth will be discussed. (Dr Philip Mitchell)</p>

4.00 - 5.00pm	<p>Endodontic-Periodontal Inter-relationships: Optimal Treatment Choices</p> <p>The dental pulp and the periodontium of a tooth are closely related. Infectious or inflammatory processes affecting each entity are usually easily diagnosed and treated. However, there might be other aetiologies leading to inflammation of the dental pulp and periodontium, often with confusing symptoms. This could pose some problems in determining the cause and the correct treatment. The presentation will look at the aetiologies, diagnosis and treatment of the "endo-perio" lesion. (Dr Robert Ng)</p>

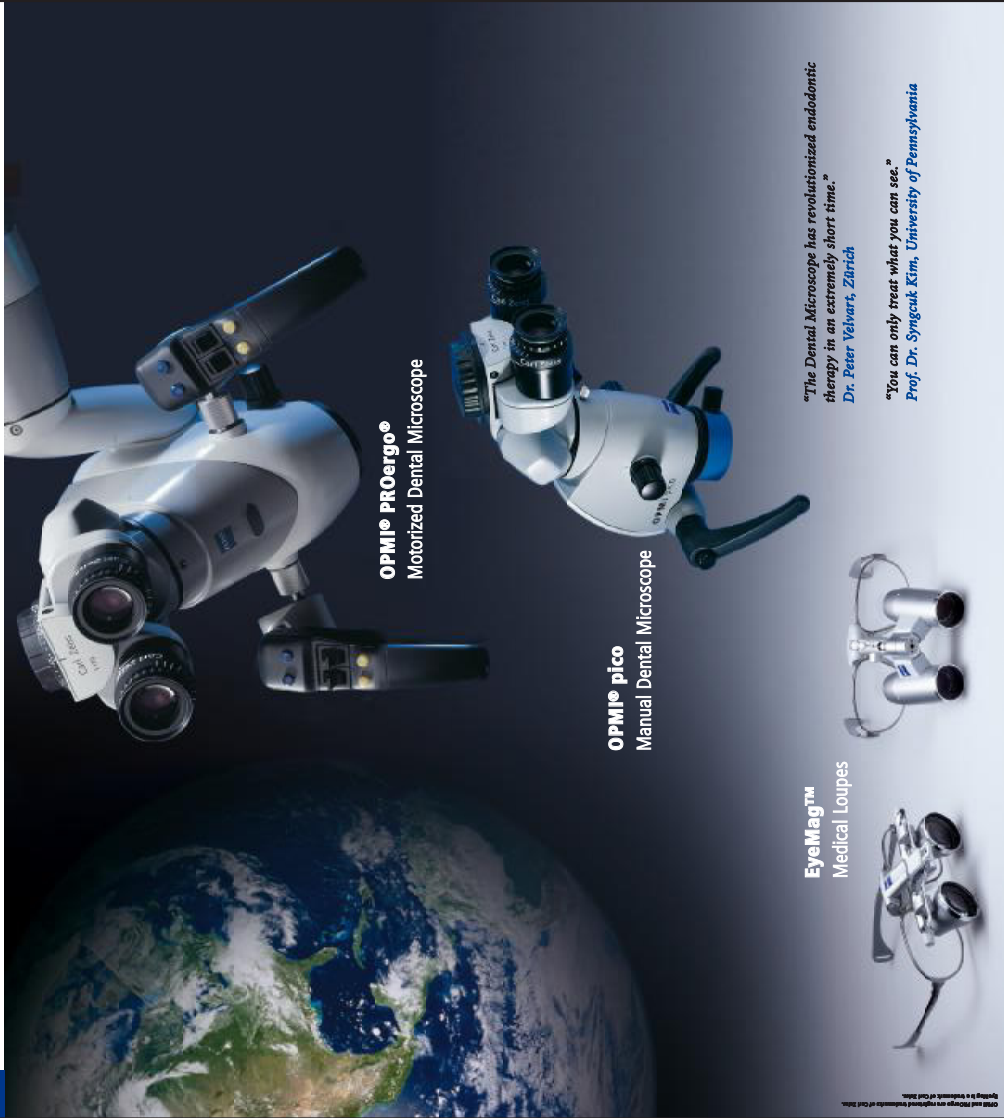
